As a social theorist with a focus on digital labor economies and a PhD from the University of Chicago, I bring an active research agenda and a strong record of peer-reviewed publications that align with your department’s strengths in economic and political sociology.

My current project, *Platformed Precarity: Labor, Surveillance, and Autonomy in the Gig Economy*, draws on ethnographic research conducted across three U.S. cities. It investigates algorithmic management and worker agency within ride-hailing platforms. Findings from this study have appeared in *Sociological Theory*, *New Media & Society*, and *Work, Employment and Society*. I am currently developing the manuscript into a monograph that has received interest from two university presses.

Beyond my primary research, I collaborate with colleagues in information studies and public policy, contributing to NSF-funded work on AI governance and employment law. I look forward to expanding this interdisciplinary engagement within UW–Madison’s collaborative academic environment.

Teaching is another core priority. At the University of Chicago, I have led upper-division seminars such as *Technology and Inequality* and introductory courses in social theory. My classroom emphasizes open dialogue, methodological rigor, and digital literacy. Several of my students have since pursued research fellowships or presented at undergraduate conferences.

I am particularly impressed by your department’s commitment to critical inquiry and empirical depth. I would be honored to contribute to your research-intensive culture, mentor graduate students, and collaborate across disciplines to further both scholarship and public impact.
